Meeting was called to order at 7:04pm by Lindy Fay.

The October MV Keynoters Booster Club Membership Meeting Minutes were read to the group. A motion was made to approve the meeting minutes as read and approved.

**Director's Report given by Ed Cloyd**

- \*The first band competition went very well. Both the band and color guard placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in there category.
- \*Marching band will be winding down by the end of the month.
- \*December concerts are coming up for all groups. Concert dates are Wed., Dec. 12<sup>th</sup> and Fri., Dec. 14<sup>th</sup>. He is encouraging all students to sell at least 2 tickets to bring in a larger audience. He is also mixing up the nights with different groups to bring in more attendees.
- \*Concert attire for each group is listed on the Keynoter website.
- \*Interest has been generated on campus from students to join the various groups next year!
- \*Contra Costa Honor Band auctions are in the beginning of December. Approximately 22 students have expressed interest in participating. Honor band tapes are due in 1 ½ weeks.
- \*Money from the state has been allotted to us although no final dollar amount has been given yet. Hopefully Mr. Cloyd will have a number tomorrow.
- \*Upcoming events – Wood Creek Jazz Festival in Roseville and the Folsom Jazz Festival.

**Board Reports:**

*ASB Account changes – Terry Moon*

\*District is making schools follow the ASB rules more strictly which means we must also. Terry can no longer “manage” the account, but she can advise. Two students will instead be working on the account under the guidance of Mr. Cloyd. He will be assisting in the decision making process with the students. Due to these changes, Terry can no longer be the ASB Treasurer. Therefore, a motion was made to amend the by-laws by removing the position of ASB Treasurer. Motion was approved.

*Keynoter Treasurer Report – Suzi Petersen*

\*Revised Keynoter Budget – a new budget for this year has been made due to a new director coming on board. The new budget mirrors more of the needs of Mr. Cloyd. A motion was made to accept the revised Keynoter Budget. Motion was approved. (Budget attached)

\*Only 50% of the parents are donating to Keynoters.

\*\$4432 was collected for cookie dough. Proceeds are distributed to student accounts.

\*An external audit was done by parent, Joan Lockie, on the Keynoter books. She made some suggestions as to changes to make in procedures otherwise our financial records are fine.

**Committee Reports:**

*Fundraising:*

*Spring Fling* dinner will be March 7<sup>th</sup> in the Commons here on campus. The theme is 50's oriented with all family members invited and encouraged to attend. The fundraiser will benefit all groups. Menu may be hot dogs, hamburgers, fries, shakes – 50's orientation. The Culinary group has been asked if they can prepare the food for the event. The first committee

meeting for this event will be held later this month. The committee needs everyone to help with obtaining auction items for the event.

*Printer Cartridges* – the first batch was picked up and we collected \$111 after less than a month. We can have boxes put into places of businesses – please consider one at your office place or at an associates. As businesses if we can put one there to help support the MVHS Keynoters group!

*Scrip* – Macy's scrip available now in the following denominations -\$25, \$50, and \$100. The Keynoters make 8% of the face amount with 4% of this going directly to the students account. Consider Macy's scrip for your holiday shopping or for gifts!

*Escrip* is also another great way to support Keynoters. It can be just your Safeway card or all your debit and credit cards. Friends and relatives can do it to and support Keynoters. Make sure you indicate Monte Vista HS Keynoters as there are many Monte Vista HS across the country!
